An old family tradition of giving thanks

On 26th November of this year USA people celebrated Thanksgiving. It is a federal holiday, celebrated on the fourth Thursday of November. It is regarded as the beginning of the fall—winter holiday season, which includes Christmas and the New Year.

It is the time when relatives can finally enjoy their time together. Families can often have their own unique traditions on that day.



The centerpiece of the celebrations is Thanksgiving dinner.

The dinner usually consists of foods and dishes indigenous to the Americas, namely turkey, mashed potatoes, stuffing, squash, corn, green beans, cranberries sauce, and pumpkin pie.



Each year at Thanksgiving, the president of the United States receives a gift of two live turkeys. At a White House ceremony, the president traditionally "pardons" the National Thanksgiving Turkeys so they can live on a farm.



Many families watch the New York City Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade, which includes marching bands, floats, songs and performances from Broadway musicals, and giant helium-filled balloons.



Volunteering and helping those in need is a very popular activity on that day.





The celebration of the genocide

Nowadays, it becomes more and more important to be educated and respectful of other's cultures and history. Not enough people know what really happened between Native Americans and Pilgrims. The real story behind the holiday is so dark, that some are rethinking how they celebrate the holiday, or whether they should at all. Thanks to Abraham Lincoln's trying to whitewash a dirty crime, people learn in school about a friendly dinner instead of a massacre that it really was.

In fact, when the pilgrims reached Cape Cod, they were incredibly unprepared for the winter. In a state of desperation, they robbed corn from Native American's graves and storehouses. So, in the march of 1621, formal agreement was made between the settlers and the native people to protect each other from other tribes. When the Pilgrims and the Wampanoag sat down for the first Thanksgiving that year, it was likely just a routine English harvest celebration.

Eventually, despite the agreement, the settlers committed a genocide and stole the land.

Now, Native Americans are only 1,5% of the population of the USA. Many Indigenous people observe **the National Day of Mourning** instead. Some people view the holiday as a reminder of the systemic racism and oppression Native Americans continue to experience in the US.

Let's acknowledge such a nauseating event and not forget such beautiful and spiritual aulture.

"Hitler's concept of concentration camps as well as the practicality of genocide owed much, so he claimed, to his studies of English and United States history. He admired the camps for Boer prisoners in South Africa and for the Indians in the wild west; and often praised to his inner circle the efficiency of America's extermination – by starvation and uneven combat – of the red savages who could not be tamed by captivity."

DIFFERENT COUNTRIES – ONE CONCEPT



Последнее воскресенье ноября — самый искренний день, когда мы признаемся своим Мамам в безграничной любви к ним. Он посвящен самой любимой и самой главной женщине, подарившей возможность жить и радоваться жизни.

День Матери в России - относительно молодой праздник, по сравнению с другими. В 1998 его закрепили на государственном

уровне и теперь отмечают ежегодно каждое последнее воскресенье ноября. Инициатором создания такого праздника на официальном уровне выступила гражданка А. Апарина. Основной посыл - напоминание о ценностях семьи, уважении и обычаях.

День матери в России отмечается не очень широко. В этот день дети поздравляют своих мам, вручают им сделанные своими руками подарки: рисунки, аппликации, поделки. Проходят различные социальной активности, главная цель которых — заботливое и бережное отношение к матери, распространение семейных ценностей и традиций.

Mother's Day in Great Britain

Mother's Day or Mothering Sunday, which is celebrated on the fourth Sunday of Lent, is similar to Women's Day in Russia.

Its roots go back to Victorian times, when children at a fairly early age worked away from home, and the money they earned was sent to the family budget.

Big presents for Mother's Day are usually not made: women receive bouquets of flowers, boxes of chocolates, some other sweets or symbolic gifts. Sometimes instead of a gift they receive an invitation to a restaurant, but more often the holiday is celebrated at home, with the family.

On Mother's Day, women do not do housework: children and husbands take care of all the cleaning and cooking. The

most popular dish for this holiday is the famous Simnel marzipan pie, which is also made for Easter, although sometimes the British make different pastries or buy a pre-ordered cake or pie.

English Easter cake Simnel is made from dough with a lot of dried fruits - raisins, dried apricots, dried cherries, as well as ginger and liqueur. The cake is topped with marzipan layers and twelve marzipan balls. There are many cooking options, and in every family the cupcake may be slightly different: someone cooks with cranberries, someone with peach

jam.





Mother's Day in the USA

On the second Sunday in May, all of America celebrates one of the warmest, most beautiful and tender holidays that touches every person on Earth - Mother's Day.

This is not only an official holiday of the country, but also a deeply personal event for Americans: statistics show that 1606 people have added it to their personal calendar, including: 614 women and 616 men, the remaining number of citizens without gender.

From early in the morning, American children congratulate their mothers by presenting them with flowers and handmade souvenirs. A special ritual is to get up quietly in the morning and, protecting mother's sleep, prepare her

favorite breakfast, so that then it can be served directly in bed.

In the USA and Australia, sons adorn their clothes with a flower. The red carnation indicates that the mother is alive and well, but the



white flowers symbolize the memory of the departed mothers.

If at first the holiday meant congratulating only mothers, now on this day in the USA it is customary to congratulate women who cared and raised. These can be grandmothers, cousins, aunts, mother-in-law.

Comment se passe la fête des mères en france? Dans l'hexagone, la coutume la plus répandue est d'offrir un cadeau à sa maman. Ils sont souvent accompagnés d'une carte de Fête des Mères dans laquelle l'enfant à inscrit quelques mots doux ou collé un joli poème. Il est coutume de lui dire "Bonne Fête, maman!" et de la couvrir de bisous et de calins. Les enfants ne s'en privent que rarement! Une fois adultes, les grands enfants continent de prendre le temps de gâter leur maman et de leur acheter un cadeau. De plus en plus de français optent pour des cadeaux originaux ou personnalisés. L'histoire de la fête des mères en france. La Fête des Mères est donc célébrée officiellement un dimanche en fonction de la date de la fête de la Pentecôte. C'est en 1897 que l'Alliance Nationale contre la dépopulation lance l'idée d'une fête des enfants pour célébrer les valeurs familiales et la natalité. L'idée ne nait réellement qu'en 1906 quand l'Union Fraternelle des Pères de Famille Méritants d'Artas organise la première célébration des Mères de famille en récompensant les plus méritantes. L'idée est reprise en 1918 par le Colonel de la Croix-Laval à Lyon qui organise la "Journée des mères". Divers tentatives et fêtes sont organisées, mais il faut attendre le régime de Vichy et le 25 mai 1941 pour que la Fête des mères devienne une fête officielle en France à l'initiative du Maréchal Pétain. Durant et après la libération cette fête est mise à l'index, car créée sous Pétain. La présence américaine d'après-guerre et l'importance des cartes envoyées à l'occasion du "Mother's day" ont permis de gommer l'image négative de la Fête des Mères en France. Le 24 mai 1950, Vincent Auriol, Président de la République institue la Fête des Mères comme fête officielle en France. Depuis, les mamans sont fêtées tous les ans au même moment de l'année et dans le monde entier.



Donc, la Fête des Mères est une journée spécialement consacrée aux mamans. L'organisation en est généralement confiée à leurs enfants qui peuvent décider de leur préparer le repas. La complicité du papa leur permet de garder un effet de surprise.
